Department Rules

1. **NATIONAL Show Ring Code of Ethics will apply to this and all departments – Please read carefully.**
2. Exhibitors must own the animals they are showing. Breeding animals may be leased and proof of lease agreement is required with the entry form.

3. Exhibitors must show their own animals.
4. Dairy exhibitors must show in “show whites”.
5. Care and preparation of the animals is the responsibility of the exhibitor. (See National Show Ring Code of Ethics)
6. Milking stands must stay in the designated grooming area.
7. All goats must be fed and watered prior to 8:00 am and 5:00 pm each day. Goats will be penned by 4-H Club or FFA Chapter and all stalls, pen areas and aisles must be kept clean and neat.
8. Special fencing must be provided by exhibitors with kids to prevent them from leaving their pens.
9. Unruly, unsafe or animals that are not halter broken will not be allowed to show.

Division A - Dairy Goats

Dairy Goat Division Rules

1. Animals may be registered or grade. Classes will be developed according to entries received. Classes/Breed Divisions containing less than three (3) entries will be combined to compete within the All Other Breeds Division.
2. Dairy Goats will be classified according to the description for each breed. Dairy crossbreeds will be entered in the All Other Breeds Division.
3. Animals shown in groups may also be shown as individuals.
4. Goats must be dehorned.

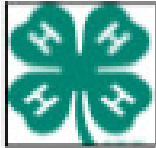

Division A - Market Goats

Market Goat Division Rules

1. **A maximum of two Market Goats may be entered.** Animals may be registered or grade, but must be at least 50% Boer.
2. Wether or doe kids are eligible.
3. Kids entered must have all milk teeth without evidence of eruption of either of two permanent front teeth.
4. Kids must be dehorned and sheared with no more than 1/2 inch of hair growth, except below the knees, hocks and tail switch.
5. Animals are subject to reclassification at weigh-in.

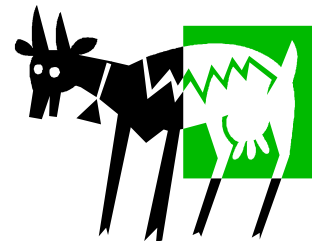

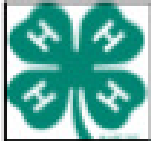
