### **Class Times and Fees**

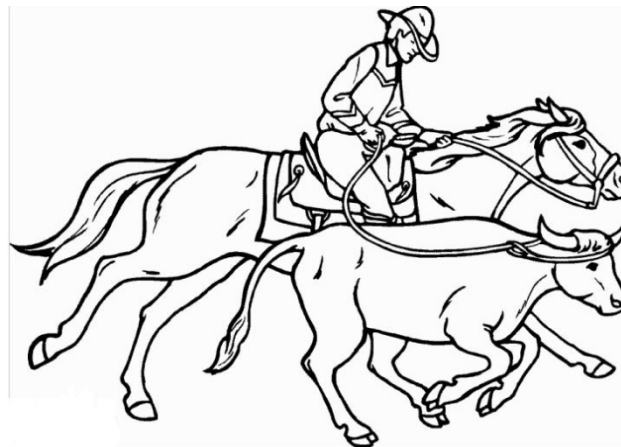

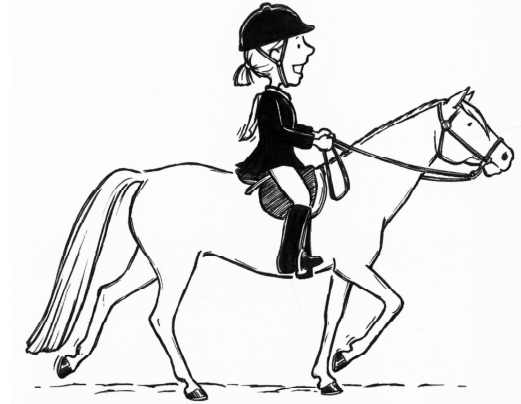
